



Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB)

The main campus of Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) is located in Bellaterra, some 10 kilometers from Barcelona city center and was founded in 1968. The campus is home to 43,000 students of which 2,500 students come from foreign countries. UAB is a young public university, but in its short history it has moved forward at a rapid pace especially in the area of research. UAB is among the best educational institutions in Spain and the European Union in terms of the quality of teaching and research, and they aim to prepare professionals in all fields of study. UAB offers a wide range of courses, with 75 undergraduate

degrees, 73 doctoral programs, 123 postgraduate programs and 151 specialization courses. The UAB campus hosts a number of research centers and institutes, which together with various academic departments make up the research consortium known as the Esfera UAB. Mays MBA/MS students who have completed their first year of the masters program will have the opportunity to study at UAB in classes conducted (about 75%) in Spanish and the rest in English. UAB exchange program is aimed at graduate students wishing to get a thorough understanding of Spanish and European business environment. You could receive up to 12 hours of elective course credit towards your master's degree.
