Founded in 1989, the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid is located in Madrid, the capital of Spain since 1562. Madrid is situated in the very center of the Iberian Peninsula and counts among its highlights as being the medieval center built at the time of the Habsburg Empire. Universidad Carlos III de Madrid is a major Spanish university with under-graduate, masters, and doctoral programs.

Innovation is the mantra of Carlos III University. Carlos III University of Madrid was founded with the objective of offering efficient, high quality public education.

Universidad Carlos III de Madrid is located in two locations, Getafe and Leganes. Both locations are south of the Madrid metropolitan area and are easily reached by both train and bus. Madrid, with approximately four million inhabitants, is one of the major capitals of Western Europe. Students will find ample opportunities to enjoy social, cultural and recreational activities in a city known

for its rare blend of character, tradition, modernity and informality.
