Copenhagen Business School (CBS) was founded in 1917 as a private institution by the Danish Society for the Advancement of Business Education. In 1965 CBS was integrated into the national system of higher education and became a self-governing institution. CBS is the largest and one of the best business school in Northern Europe with strong emphasis on education and research. With approximately 13,500 students, of which some 9,000 are full-time, CBS offers degree programs up to and including the Ph.D. CBS works closely with the business community on the development of school's programs to ensure that the quality of instruction, programs, and research meet the requirements of a labor market characterized by constant changes and growing international competition.

CBS's prime location in Copenhagen, a city of 1.8 million inhabitants and Denmark's administrative, financial and cultural capital, provides the school with excellent opportunities for close cooperation with experts and top managers in Denmark as well as abroad. CBS is an urban university with its campus located in two modern buildings in Frederiksberg, close to the heart of Copenhagen. Almost everyone in Denmark speaks English.

Eligible MBA/MS students from Mays Business School can participate in semester-long programs at CBS. You will have access to all CBS courses listed in their course catalog provided you meet the necessary prerequisites. Most courses are taught in English. You must enroll for a minimum of 9 credit hours at TAMU per semester at CBS. Other program details are listed below.
