(EDHEC) Lille & Nice, France



EDHEC Business School (EDHEC) is a private Grande Ecole. It has campuses in Lille (north of France) and Nice (south of France). L'EDHEC Graduate School of Management is part of the Catholic University of Lille (15,000 students). As one of the top five French business schools, EDHEC accounts for more than 2,200 students on its two campuses. The EDHEC programs are of three years duration, leading to a Diplôme EDHEC, beyond a two-year pre-business program (classes Préparatoires), which is provided to students who have completed high school. Other degrees offered are the MASTERE (one year postgraduate studies), a two year MBA program, and a three-year doctoral program.

Texas A&M University (TAMU) business students with an interest in European Union Business and who have completed their first year of masters program, will have the opportunity to spend one



semester at Lille or Nice. You could receive up to 12 hours of elective course credit towards your masters degree and you will work along with other American and European peers. Courses will be taught by European specialists including lawyers, managers of MNCs, and EDHEC faculty.
