L' **Universite de Strasbourg** with 33,000 students is located in Alsace province, in one of France's most dynamic regions. Strasbourg is the home of the European Parliament and is the seat of the Council of Europe as well as the Court of Human Rights. It is a student-friendly city and is an ideal city in which to study.

Ecole de Management Strasbourg, is the business school of the University and of Strasbourg. It receives support from both the State University System and the Chamber of Commerce which is unique among French business schools. EM Strasbourg is European and international in its orientation with many interdisciplinary courses offered in international business (European Politics and Economics, International Economics, International Trade, International Business Management, and Intercultural Management). Students attending EM Strasbourg develop an understanding of the international culture throughout the curriculum, both in class and within the multi-cultural environment.



Graduate students at Texas A&M University (TAMU), can take courses during the regular semesters at EM Strasbourg. You must enroll for at least a semester of course work in the third year of the EM Strasbourg program. You must register for a minimum of nine credit hours of course work each semester at TAMU. French is not a requirement, since some 20 courses are offered in English each semester. Knowledge of French will be helpful to take full advantage of the academic and cultural environment.
