The Indian Institute of Management Bangalore (IIMB) was established in 1973 by the Government of India in cooperation with the State of Karnataka of which Bangalore is the capital. Located some 10 miles from the heart of the city, IIMB is situated in a lush 100-acre campus on the southern outskirts of Bangalore. IIMB's unique layout consists of local granite buildings surrounded by green lawns, well-maintained gardens, and patches of natural forest that provide a serene environment for learning.

The two-year full time Post Graduate Program in Management (an MBA program) is IIMB's flagship program, with some 300 students admitted each year. Exchange students enroll in this full-time MBA Program.



Enterprise Management, independent of their MBA Program. The MBA Program is spread over six terms and TAMU students can attend the 5th Term that generally runs from the first week of September through the end of November.

Eligible MBA/MS students from Texas A&M University (TAMU) can take courses during IIMB's Term V (early September – end November). You must register for a minimum of nine credit hours of course work at TAMU while you are enrolled at IIMB. Other program details:
