The Johannes Kepler University is located in Linz, Austria, a city of 200,000 inhabitants on the Danube river. JKU has a modern campus with 15,000 students and offers various programs in Business, Economics, Sciences, and Law. Its Institute for International Management Studies prepares students for the “Magister in International Business Administration” --a masters program in business. The main objective of this program is to focus on Austrian and European social, legal, and economic systems, and global business.

Johannes Kepler University Linz is a young, progressive and dynamic institution of higher education and research. It is not only famous for its high quality of teaching and research, but has also earned a reputation as an attractive partner for businesses

and various social and governmental institutions.

All colleges of JKU are located on campus that covers some 350,000 m² space. The athletic grounds and three student residences are located directly on site. Two more student residences -among them the largest that holds about 1300 students - are situated within a five minute walking distance from school.

MBA/MS students can spend a semester at Johannes Kepler University and receive up to 12 hours of elective course credit toward their Texas A&M masters degree. Elective course work in Accounting, Finance, Human Resources, Marketing, Management, MIS, Operations, and International business must be taken in the German language. Additionally, German language classes are also available.
