Jonkoping International Business School

Jonkoping, Sweden

Jonkoping International Business School (JIBS), was founded in 1993 as part of Jonkoping University, which is over a hundred years old. Jonkoping University has a total of some 8,000 students of which about 1,500 are with JIBS. JIBS and the School of Engineering focus on internationalization and entrepreneurship. Jonkoping is the center for small and medium-size enterprises in Sweden – a true characteristics of the region.

JIBS caters to the needs of the future. In contrast to most other public Swedish business schools, JIBS is a foundation-owned (has the freedom of a private school while receiving public funding) business school with genuine global orientation. It has excellent bachelor, masters and doctoral programs along with world-renowned research. Because of its extensive international student exchange program, students gain better knowledge of global conditions and cultural differences. JIBS has also close relationships with companies and organizations in the private as well as public sectors. JIBS offers bachelors and masters degree in business administration, economics, commercial law and business information systems. Ph.D. degrees are offered in business administration, economics, commercial law and political science.

Eligible MBA/MS students from Texas A&M University (TAMU) can take courses during JIBS's fall (mid August – Christmas) or spring (mid January – early June). You must register for a minimum of nine credit hours of course work each semester at TAMU while you are enrolled at JIBS. Other program details:
