Founded 1896, Beijing Jiaotong University is a nationally recognized institution in diverse academic areas. The university focuses on engineering and business with specialization in information/communications, management, and economics. The School of Economics and Management, one of the nine schools of the university, was established in 1996, by combining the former School of Economics, Department of Material Management Engineering, and Department of Industry and Construction Management Engineering. In 1999, it was renamed as the School of Economics and Management.



Eligible Mays Business School undergraduate students will be permitted to participate in semester-long programs at Beijing Jiaotong University (Fall: first week of September until mid-January or Spring: end February/early March until mid-July). You must register for a minimum of 12 credit hours of course work per semester at TAMU while you are enrolled at Beijing Jiaotong University.

Semester Dates:

Fall: first week of September until mid-January

Spring: end February/early March until mid-July

Estimated incremental (additional) cost of studying at Beijing Jiaotong University:

Airfare: \$ 1,600 (approximate)

Additional living expenses: About the same as TAMU, College Station
