Copenhagen Business School (CBS) was founded in 1917 as a private institution by the Danish Society for the Advancement of Business Education. In 1965 CBS was integrated into the national system of higher education and became a self-governing institution. CBS is the largest business school in Northern Europe with strong emphasis on education and research. With approximately 13,500 students, of which some 9,000 are full-time, CBS offers degree programs up to and including the Ph.D. CBS works closely with the business community on the development of school's programs to ensure that the quality of instruction, programs, and research meet the requirements of a labor market characterized by constant changes and growing international competition. CBS's prime location in Copenhagen, a city of 1.8 million inhabitants and Denmark's administrative, financial and cultural capital, provides the school with excellent opportunities for close cooperation with experts and top managers within Denmark as well as abroad. CBS is an urban university with its campus located in two modern buildings in Frederiksberg, close to the heart of Copenhagen. Almost everyone in Denmark speaks English.

Mays Business School upperclass undergraduate students will be permitted to participate in semester-long programs at CBS. You will have access to all CBS courses provided that you meet the necessary course prerequisites. Most courses are taught in English and are taken by CBS degree students as well. You must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours [equivalent to 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)] at TAMU per semester at CBS.
