EM Strasbourg is located in Strasbourg, in one of France's most dynamic regions - Alsace. Strasbourg, seat of the Council of Europe and of the European Parliament, is an ideal city in which to study.

EM Strasbourg, is the business school of the University of Strasbourg. It receives support from both the State University System and the Chamber of Commerce that is unique among French business schools. EM Strasbourg is European and international in its orientation with many interdisciplinary courses offered in international business (European Politics and Economics, International Economics, International Trade, International Business Management, and Intercultural Management).



Students attending EM Strasbourg develop an understanding of the international culture throughout the curriculum, both in class and within the multi-cultural environment.

Undergraduate business majors, usually at the junior level, will be permitted to take courses during the regular semesters provided by EM Strasbourg. You must enroll for at least a semester of course work in either the second or third year of the EM Strasbourg program and register for 12 credit hours of course work each semester at TAMU. French is not a requirement, since some 20 courses are offered in English each semester. Knowledge of French will be helpful to take full advantage of the academic and cultural experience.
