Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) was founded in 1991 as a world-class technological university. HKUST is the third publicly-funded university in Hong Kong with a total enrollment of 7,000 students at the undergraduate, masters and doctoral levels. With an internationally distinguished faculty and a modern campus housing state-of-the-art teaching and research facilities, HKUST is a dynamic educational institution.

The School of Business and Management has an international focus in its teaching, research and service functions. It comprises six departments: Accounting, Economics, Finance, Information and Systems Management, Management of Organizations and Marketing.

About 40% of business students are undergraduates and each department offers undergraduate as well as masters and doctoral degree programs. Undergraduate programs at the School of Business and Management are based on four main pillars: broad-based business and management education; global perspectives and international outlook; strong language and communication skills; and integration of theory and practice.

Eligible Mays Business School students will be permitted to participate in semester-long programs at HKUST. You must register for a minimum of 12 credit hours of course work per semester at TAMU while you are enrolled at HKUST.
