Jönköping International Business School (JIBS), was founded in 1993 as part of Jonkoping University, which is over a hundred years old. Jonkoping University has a total of some 8,000 students of which about 1,500 are degree-seeking. JIBS and the School of Engineering focus on internationalization, entrepreneurship, small and medium-size enterprise development – a true characteristics of the region.

JIBS caters to the needs of the future. In contrast to most other Swedish business schools, JIBS is a foundation-owned (has the freedom of a private school while receiving public funding) business school with genuine international orientation. It has a dynamic bachelor/masters program as well as doctoral programs along with world-renowned research. Because of its extensive international student exchange program, students gain better knowledge of international conditions and cultural differences. JIBS also has close relationships with companies and organizations in both the private and public sectors. JIBS offers bachelors and masters degree in business administration, economics, commercial law and business information systems.



Eligible Mays Business School students will be permitted to take courses during JIBS's fall (mid August – Christmas) or spring (mid January – early June) semester. You must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours at TAMU [equivalent to 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) credits of course work] per semester at JIBS.
