Maastricht University, formerly the University of Limburg in Maastricht (The Netherlands), was founded in 1976. It is one of the youngest of the twelve Dutch universities. At present there are some 7,000 students in five schools. In addition to classical business and economics curricula, the Department of Economics and Business Administration offers three international programs: International Business Studies, International Management, and International Economic Studies.

MU attracts students from all over the world. Not only the university, but also the city of Maastricht has a strong international character mainly due to its location only 5 km from the border with Belgium and 35 km from Germany. Cities like Amsterdam, Paris, Brussels,



Frankfurt and Bonn are all within easy reach, while the local airport serves as a gateway to several other European countries. Maastricht is the oldest and, with its wealth of historical buildings, one of the most attractive cities in the Netherlands.

Undergraduate Mays Business School students at the junior level, will be permitted to take courses during Maastricht's regular semesters. You must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours at TAMU per semester of study at Maastricht.
