Oslo, the capital of Norway is an exciting city bounded by the Oslo Fjord in the south and unspoiled natural woodlands to the north and east. With a relatively small population of about half a million, Oslo is beautifully situated in surroundings, which few major cities can boast. Norway is long and narrow, with more than 30% of the land covered by forests. With numerous rivers and lakes and with nearly half the landmass covered with



mountain ranges Norway offers diversity and breathtaking beauty.

As an undergraduate exchange student, you will attend classes at BINBS's Oslo Campus, which is centrally located in the eastern part of Oslo close to Grunerlokka. Approximately 5000 students attend different programs at the Oslo Campus. Courses for exchange students are taught in English and some courses are specifically designed for exchange students. A beginners course in Norwegian is offered free of charge by Rosenhoff Adult Education Center.

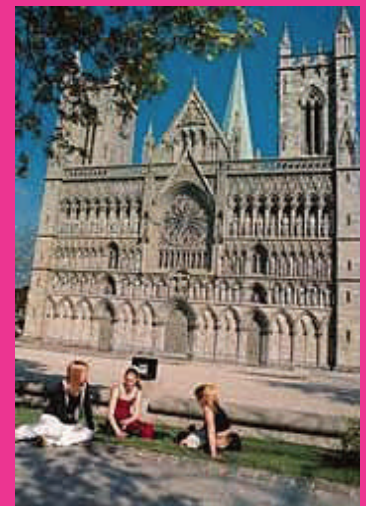
