

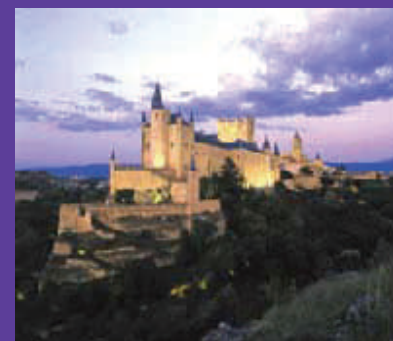


## Universitat Pompeu Fabra Barcelona, Spain



Universitat Pompeu Fabra is located in the heart of Catalonia, Spain. Founded in 1990, the University is meeting the challenge to improve the overall quality of higher education through its stress on high standards in teaching and research, and by its firm commitment to international cooperation, which includes university scholar and student exchange. Universitat Pompeu Fabra offers degrees in Law, Business, Economics, Communication, Journalism, and Languages.

Students must be fluent in Spanish to be able to attend classes and take full advantage of the academic and cultural experience.
