## Tübingen, Germany



Tübingen University, located in the old city of Tübingen (population 75,000) in Germany, was founded in 1477. Today its students enjoy a mixture of traditional and cosmopolitan atmosphere. The University is well known for research and the university is the biggest employer in southern Württemberg. The latest results of scientific research flow directly into the University's curriculum, thus guaranteeing an up-to-date education. The university is also famous for its hospital and medical school.



Tübingen's contemporary appearance is characterized by 23,000 students living in a comparatively small city of 85,000. While the majority of the liberal arts departments and institutions are located in the old part of Tübingen, the modern Science Center was built twenty years ago on the hills overlooking

the town. The University's academic reputation is determined by the research achievements of more than 700 professors and about 2,000 academic assistants. At their disposal is not only the latest technical equipment, but also extensive library facilities.

Undergraduate Texas A&M University students will be permitted to take courses during the regular semesters provided by Tübingen University. You must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours at TAMU per semester at Tübingen. You must be fluent in German to be able to attend classes and take full advantage of the academic and cultural experience.
