The Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB), located in Bellaterra, a Barcelona suburb, was founded in 1968. It is therefore a young university, but in its short history it has moved forward at a rapid pace. UAB is now among the best education establishments in Spain and the European Union in terms of the quality of teaching and research.

To achieve their objectives, UAB offers a wide range of degrees, with 75 undergraduate programs, 73 doctoral programs, 123 postgraduate programs and 151 specialization courses. UAB campus hosts a number of research centers and institutes, which together with the departments that make up the research consortium known as the Esfera UAB.

Mays upperclass undergraduate students will have the opportunity to study at UAB in classes conducted about 75% in Spanish and the rest in English. The program is aimed at students wishing to get a thorough understanding of the European business environment. You could receive up to 12 hours of elective course credit towards your degree.



Undergraduate Mays Business School students at the junior level, will be permitted to take courses during UAB's regular semesters. You must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours at TAMU per semester of study at UAB.

Language Requirement: Spanish (about 75%) and the rest in English
