## Scholarship information

JKU is accepting nominations from non-European exchange partners for student scholarships funded through the project *Innovatives Oberösterreich 2010 PLUS*.

The following scholarship types are available:

- 1) Full Scholarships (€ 550 per month)
- 2) Accommodation Scholarships
- 3) Travel and Top-Up Scholarships (up to € 1,000)

The type(s) and the amount of the scholarship awarded are at the discretion of JKU.

The target audience for these scholarships is exchange students wishing to pursue study at JKU. Grants will be awarded to academic year and semester participants in order to encourage students with a genuine interest in study abroad, who do not have sufficient financial resources, to apply for an exchange at JKU. The award criteria for the scholarships include academic background, genuine financial need, desire to improve language ability as well as the exchange balance.

## Requirements

- 1) Must be a nominee for JKU under the terms of an exchange agreement outside Erasmus.
- 2) Applicants should also demonstrate financial need.
- 3) Mandatory completion of a post-exchange student evaluation form.
- 4) **Scholarship Application Form** signed and endorsed by the home exchange coordinator

## Deadline

Nominations for the winter semester (starting in Mid-September) should be submitted to the International Office of JKU by **June 1** (priority deadline), for the summer semester (starting in Mid-February) by **December 1**. Applicants will be notified in mid-June and mid-December respectively.
