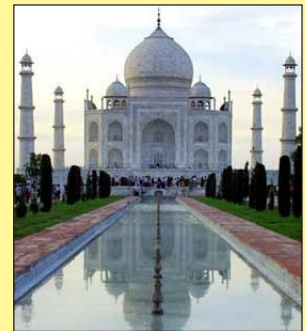
Participants in this specially designed, two week business and culture program in India will receive three credit hours as follows:

**IBUS 489:** India Business Environment

**Language of instruction:** English

The January 2012 India Business Environment program will be conducted with SDM-Institute for Management Development, a partner institution of Mays Business School that is located in Mysore. Seven predeparture sessions will be held at Mays Business School in Fall 2011.

**Eligibility:** This program is open to Mays Business School students who are part of the class of 2014 or earlier. Selection to the program is on a competitive basis.



**Application Deadline: September 16, 2011**

**Faculty Information:** The India Business Environment program will be conducted by Dr. Julian Gaspar, Executive Director, Center for International Business Studies, Mays Business School, and professors from SDM-IMD.

- Ground transportation to several corporate and group cultural visits in Bangalore, Mysore, New Delhi, and Agra (Taj Mahal)
