Participants in this specially designed, five-week, intensive European program will receive six credit hours as follows:

IBUS 446/FINC 445 Funding International Business (Credit 3 Hours). PPA Students may register for FINC 645.
Prerequisite: FINC 341 with a grade of C or better

IBUS 301 Study Abroad holding course that will convert to IBUS 456 European Union Integration & Business upon return to TAMU (Credit 3 Hours)

Language of instruction: English

The Summer 2012 European Union Business Environment Study Abroad program will be conducted with Ecole de Management

Strasbourg, a partner institution of Mays Business School that is located on the French-German border in Alsace Province, France.

Eligibility

This program is open only to Mays Business School students who could be admitted to upper level studies prior to participation in the program. Mays students desiring to participate in the program must have a minimum cumulative GPR of 2.5. Selection to the program is on a competitive basis.

Faculty Information

The Strasbourg Study Abroad program will be conducted by Professors Julian Gaspar, Mays, and Ludwig Kreitz, Ecole de Management Strasbourg.

Estimated Program Costs of \$3,500 Covers:

- Lodging/room (shared with a roommate)
- A meal allowance of 15 euros/day
- Travel to European Union institutions, corporate visits, and group cultural visits
- Four-day visit to Brussels and Paris
- Tram/bus pass for the month of June
- Travel Insurance

Costs Not Covered By Program Fee:

- \$1,500 approx. TAMU tuition & fees
- \$1,500 approx. airfare (IAH-Frankfurt-IAH)
- \$ 360 TAMU Study Abroad Service Fee
- \$ 500-1500 personal expenses (weekend travels in Europe, etc.)
